PIANIST STEVE LAW

Scott Joplin, King of Ragtime and composer of piano classics like Maple Leaf Rag The Entertainer and The Easy Winners died 100 years ago this year.

Pianist-composer Steve Law pays tribute by performing some of Joplin's greatest and best loved works. This is not just music full of catchy tunes and jazzy toe tapping rhythms, but also of great warmth, charm and melancholy. Joplin elevated ragtime from honk-tonk piano to a truly original American art form which influenced much of the early jazz age and popular music that was to follow.
